Tee Box Policy

Beginning June 11, 2015, West Point Golf Club has decided to allow players to play from their tee box of choice. We assume that most players will be opting for the White Tees with some members opting for the Red Tees.

The Golf Canada Handicap Manual has specific instructions on how to play competitions from different tee boxes. We are using their guidelines. We believe this is a fair and proven way to allow our members to further enjoy the game of golf.

Simply put:

Players who choose to play from the Red Tees will use their “**Club Index**” to find their Red Tee handicap from the appropriate Red Tee Chart. This chart is available on the website’s “**Handicaps**” page and reflects a player’s Red Tee Course Handicap minus **X** strokes for the Course Rating difference between the White and Red Tees. Pocket size copies of the charts will be available at the Captain’s Table and are also available on the “**Handicaps**” page.

Charts exist for McCleery now and will be made available for Langara and Fraserview prior to play at those locations. **X** is dependent upon the course being played and equals **3** for McCleery and Langara, and **4** for Fraserview.

You can find your **Club Index** by opening “**Record Scores**” on the website. It appears at the top of each player’s handicap record just below Home Playing Hcap.

What to do to play from the Reds:

- All you have to do is tell the Captain’s Table that you played from the Red Tees.
- Players will use our website “**Record Scores**” to enter their gross scores as always. Except they will enter their scores as having played from the *Red Tees*. All scores should be recorded as soon as possible.
